The tournament is **1 of only 3 wheelchair basketball tournaments** held in the northern Illinois region and will attract **7 other teams representing Wisconsin, Minnesota and Indiana**. NEDSRA’s gymnasium, the only one of its kind in Illinois built specifically to meet the unique needs of wheelchair athletes, will host some **200-250 tournament supporters and spectators during the event.**
